

Legal Description

Land in Davidson County, Tennessee, being Lot No. 3, Brigid Ann Heights, Section II, as of record in Book 4660, page 149, Register's Office for Davidson County, Tennessee, to which plat reference is hereby made for a more complete description.

Being the same property conveyed to Charles N. Armstrong, Robert Brannon, Kennedy Green, Clarence C. Shaub and Carl E. Watts, being all of the Trustees of Otter Creek Church of Christ, their heirs and assigns, by deed from James L. Murphy, Jr. and wife Mary Ann Murphy, of record in Book 4899, page 783, Register's Office for Davidson County, Tennessee.

LAND in the 7th, formerly the 11th, Civil District of Davidson County, Tennessee, being the westerly 218 feet front and 222 feet rear of lots Nos. 2 and 3 on the plan of J. E. Rucker's Subdivision, not of record.

According to a survey made by John Wilkes, Civil Engineer, July 3, 1935, said part of lots Nos. 2 and 3 front 218 feet on the northerly side of Otter Creek Road and runs back from the center of said Road 450 feet on the westerly line and 450 feet, more or less, on the easterly line to the southerly line of lot No. 1, measuring 222 feet thereon.
